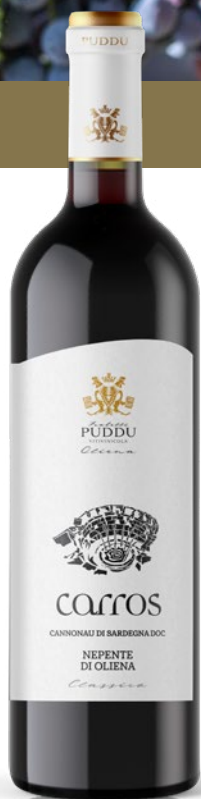

CANNONAU DI SARDEGNA DOC - NEPENTE DI OLIENA - CLASSICO



Classic Cannonau di Sardegna made with a careful selection of grapes from the Vineyard Orbuddai situated at the feet of mountain Corrasì. Best environment for Cannonau variety, this is the birthplace of a superb wine with great personality with hints of myrtle and Mediterranean scrub. For its distinctive and special characteristics it is preferred in pairing with traditional Sardinian dishes.

Appellation: Cannonau di Sardegna DOC Nepente di Oliena.

Type of wine: Classic.

Varietal composition: 100% Cannonau.

Vineyards: About 15 Vintages old, spurred cordon system, organic.

Yield: 5-6 tons per ha.

Soil: Decomposed granite soil.

Harvest: Manual harvest in crates.

Vinification: Fermentation at controlled temperature in order to preserve the typical aromas of the variety .

Maturation: 12 months in 500 lt oak barrels and another 3 months in bottles.

Appearance: Garnet red with purplish reflections.

Nose: The bouquet features immediately notes of fleshy red fruit typical of the grape variety Cannonau, a discrete and fine spiciness in the finish tends to enhance the aromatic structure.

Taste: Wine with a considerable acidic backbone, rightly tannic, overall very balanced, fruity and spicy notes reappear to complete the sensations perceived on the nose.

Alcoholic content: 14,5% Vol.

Serving temperature: Excellent if served at a temperature of 15/18 °C.

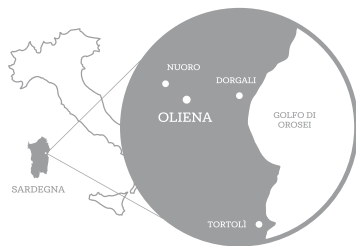

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OLIENA AND THE "NEPENTE" WINE.

In Oliena, small town in the province of Nuoro (Sardinia) we have had news about winemaking since 1500. At that time the Franciscans planted 10.000 vines of Cannonau, that here is also called Nepente, from the greek words "Ne"=no and "Penthos"=sadness, so literally no sadness.

It was the famous Italian poet Gabriele D'Annunzio the one who gave the Cannonau of Oliena this special name, during one visit in town when he had the pleasure to taste it.



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
